Camphill School, Glenraig is part of Camphill Community, Glenraig, a non-profit making charity, governed by a Board of Trustees.

Camphill Community, Glenraig is led by a Chief Executive Officer.

The school is governed through a Board of Governors which is a subcommittee, of the Children's Services Committee and is chaired by a Trustee.

The School is managed by the Head of Education.

School, families and home settings, both in the community and on site, work closely together and are supported by Health Trust Community and multi-disciplinary teams.

Each class is led by a Teacher supported by Assistant Teachers and Classroom Assistants. This team is in turn supported by external professionals and therapists brought in to meet pupils' assessed needs.

and review necessary, we hold daily Class Meetings and operate a Mentoring and Supervision Process to provide support and guidance to staff.

During Weekly Staff Development meetings, we work collaboratively to review and improve practice whilst the weekly Teachers' meeting focuses on the planning and review of our pupil's educational and pastoral goals.

For the benefit of our residential pupils, we also hold a weekly meeting to ensure consistency of approach and effective information sharing.
